3 08-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 338 dated 01.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Sheikhpura along with the report of Police Inspector cum S.H.O., Ariyari Police Station dated 29.04.2026, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant Manoj Kumar @ Manoj Singh has died.
