3 13-05-2026 Perused the Report No. 827 dated 11.05.2026 of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Muzaffarpur along with the Report dated 10.05.2026 of the Sub-Inspector of Police, Benibad Police Station, Muzaffarpur as well as the Certificate of Death dated 10.05.2026 of the Sarpanch of Gram Kachhari-Jata, Block- Gaighat, Dist.- Muzaffarpur; wherein it is indicated that all the four appellants, namely, Chulhai Sah, Ramji Sah, Mahavir Sah and Girdhari Sah, are dead.

2. In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023,



since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.

3. Let the trial court record be sent back to the concerned court immediately, if not required in any other cases.
