5 14-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 2043 dated 06.05.2026 of

the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patna, along with the
report dated 03.05.2026 of S.H.O., Imamganj P.S., Patna, as
well as the Report dated 02.05.2026, issued by the Sarpanch,
Gram Kachhari- Akbarpur Ranipur, Block-Paliganj, District-
Patna, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light
that the sole appellant, namely, Baban Singh, is dead.

2. In view of the said letters as also section 394 of the
Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to
section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023,
since no near relative has filed any application for leave to
continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and
disposed of.

concerned court immediately, if not required in any other cases.
