3 11-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 809 dated 05.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Madhepura along with the Report dated 05.05.2026 of the Inspector of Police-cum-S.H.O., Udakishunganj Police Station as well as the Certificate of Death dated 07.02.2026 of the Mukhiya of Gram Panchayat, Nayanagar, Block- Udakishungan, Madhepura; wherein it is indicated that the sole appellant, namely, Kaushal Jha @ Pancho Jha, is dead.
