3 14-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 2034 dated 06.05.2026 of
the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patna along with the Report
dated 04.05.2026 of Police Inspector-cum-S.H.O., Fatuha P.S.,
Patna as well as Report of the Member, Panchayat Samiti, Gram
Panchayat Raj Maujipur, wherein it is indicated that the sole
appellant, namely, Vijay Singh is dead.

2. In view of the said letters as also Section 394 of the
Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to
Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023,
since no near relative has filed any application for leave to
continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and
disposed of.
