3 07-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 620 dated 01.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Kaimur (Bhabua) along with the Report dated 30.04.2026 of the Probationary Sub-Inspector of Police, Sadar Police Station, Kaimur (Bhabua), wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Lalbarti Singh, is dead.

In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.
