4 12-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 544 dated 01.05.2026 of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Darbhanga along with the report of S.H.O., Biraul Police Station, Darbhanga dated 30.04.2026, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant Manji Sah has died. Death certificate of the appellant issued by the Department of Planning and Development, Government of Bihar, Patna has also been enclosed with the said report.
