5 08-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 280 dated 03.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Naugachhia, Bhagalpur along with the report dated 03.05.2026 of the Police Inspector-cum-S.H.O., Bhawanipur P.S., Bhagalpur, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry, it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Ashok Yadav, is dead and the death certificate of the appellant is annexed with the said report.

In view of the said reports as also section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to section 435 of the Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.
