6 26-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 1613 dated 14.05.2026 of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gaya along with the Report dated 13.05.2026 of the S.H.O, Sherghati Police Station, Gaya, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Kauleshwar Bhuia, is dead.
