7 17-04-2026 Perused the Letter No.501 dated 18.03.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Bhojpur, Ara along with the Report dated 18.03.2026 of SHO, Sandesh Police Station, as well as the report of Mukhiya, Gram Panchayat Pawna, Block-Agiawn, Bhojpur wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Birbal Yadav, is dead.

In view of the said letter as also section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.
