2. The accused/petitioner is not named in the FIR

and apprehending his arrest in connection with Samastipur

Muffasil P.S. Case No.40 of 2026 registered under Sections

331(4) and 305 of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (in

short 'B.N.S.').

3. As per FIR, on intervening night of 30.01.2026,

some unknown persons committed theft in the house of the

informant and stolen cable and goods related with electric

wiring worth of Rs.3,45,000/- and golden and silver

ornaments along with steel utensils worth of Rs.3,00,000/-.



4. It is submitted by learned counsel appearing for petitioner that during the course of investigation, one witness namely, Pawan Kumar, claimed himself as an eye-witness of the occurrence stated that this petitioner along with one another person namely, Rajan Kumar were found roaming near to the house of the informant. It is pointed out that only with this much suspicion, the petitioner was implicated with present case, who is otherwise a man of clean antecedent.

5. Learned APP opposed the prayer of bail.

6. In view of aforesaid factual submissions and by taking note of fact as petitioner *prima facie* appears implicated with present crime in question for the reason that he was witnessed roaming near to the house of the informant, accordingly, the petitioner, above-named, who is a man of clean antecedent, in the event of his arrest or surrender in the court below within a period of four weeks from today, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the



learned A.C.J.M.-II, Samastipur in connection with Samastipur Muffasil P.S. Case No.40 of 2026, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure (in short 'CrPC')/under Section 482(2) of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (in short 'BNSS').
