3 08-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 622 dated 01.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Banka along with the report dated 30.04.2026 of the Sub-Inspector, Rajoun P.S., Banka, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry, it came to light that the appellants, namely, Kunni Harijan and Bilash Harijan, are dead and the death certificates of both the appellants are annexed with the said report.

2. In view of the said reports as also section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to section 435 of the Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and



disposed of.
