4 26-05-2026 Perused the report dated 01.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Banka along with the report dated 30.04.2026 of the Sub-Inspector of Police-cum-S.H.O., Bandhuakurawa Police Station, Banka, which indicate that the sole appellant Wakil Paswan is dead and the death certificate of the appellant is annexed with the said report.
