4 15-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 800 dated 11.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Kaimur (Bhabhua) along with the report dated 09.05.2026 of the Sub-Inspector-cum-S.H.O., Durgawati P.S., wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Dhyan Singh, is dead and the death certificate of the appellant is annexed with the said report.
