Department of Planning and Development, Directorate of
Economics and Statistics, Government of Bihar, wherein it is
indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the both the
appellants, namely, Ismail Mian and Dhanu Singh, are dead.

2. In view of the said letters as also section 394 of the
Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to
section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023,



since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.

3. Let the trial court record be sent back to the concerned court immediately, if not required in any other cases.
