2 22-04-2026 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Atri P.S. Case No. 429 of 2025 registered for the offence under
Section(s) 103(1) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and
Section 27 of the Arms Act.

3. The petitioner is not a member of the family of the
deceased and her husband. It is said that the husband had
purchased two bullets from the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence.
Petitioner is in custody since 23.10.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently
opposed the prayer for bail.



6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the nature of allegation and the period of custody, this application for regular bail is allowed.

7. Accordingly, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Atri P.S. Case No. 429 of 2025 subject to conditions that:-

(i). The petitioner will mark his attendance at the Atri Police Station on the first and third Sunday of each month. Any default in appearance at the Police Station would result in cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner.

8. It is made clear that any observation made herein is *prima facie* in nature and limited solely for the purpose of adjudication of the present bail application. Such observations shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and shall not influence the trial or any other proceedings in any manner.
