3 07-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 477 dated 14.02.2026 of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patna along with the Report dated 09.02.2026 of the Police Inspector-cum-S.H.O., Bikram Police Station, Patna, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that both the appellants, namely, Rabindra Singh and Shree Niwas Sharma, are dead.
