5 06-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 179 dated 21.04.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Arwal along with the Report dated 21.04.2026 of the Sub-Inspector of Police-cum-S.H.O, Kinjar Police Station, Arwal, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that both the appellants, namely, Sajiwan Sao and Bhagwan Sao, are dead.

In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.
