4 10-04-2026 Perused the Letter No. 401 dated 30.03.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Vaishali along with the Report dated 30.03.2026 of the S.H.O, Bidupur Police Station, Vaishali, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Niranjan Singh, is dead.
