10 17-04-2026 Perused the Letter No. 156 dated 12.02.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Munger along with the Report dated 09.02.2026 of S.H.O. Asarganj Police Station, Munger as well as the report of Mukhiya, Gram Panchayat- Raj Jorari, Block-Asarganj, District Munger, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Md. Abbas, is dead.

In view of the said letter as also section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.
