The



authority shall endeavour to take necessary decision strictly in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of 4 weeks from the date of the receipt of the copy of this order. It is needless to observe that before taking any decisions, the petitioner shall be given an opportunity of hearing. Any decision taken by the authority shall be communicated to the party.

3. With the above directions, the present Writ Petition stands disposed of.
