learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Gwalpara P.S. Case No. 195 of 2025 registered for the offence
under Section(s) 137(2), 96 and 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya
Sanhita, 2023.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner is alleged
to have kidnapped the victim girl by luring her.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence.
Petitioner is in custody since 19.12.2025 and has clean
antecedent.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently
opposed the prayer for bail.



6. I have considered the submissions of the parties and have gone through the records of the case. From the statement of the victim girl recorded under Section 183 BNSS, it appears that she had eloped with the petitioner on her own.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, this application for regular bail is allowed.

8. Accordingly, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Gwalpara P.S. Case No. 195 of 2025.

9. It is made clear that any observation made herein is *prima facie* in nature and limited solely for the purpose of adjudication of the present bail application. Such observations shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and shall not influence the trial or any other proceedings in any manner.
