5 11-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 264 dated 05.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Sitamarhi, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Bijay Mishra, is dead and the death certificate of the appellant is annexed with the said report.
