4 24-04-2026 Perused the Letter No. 406 dated 14.02.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Nalanda along with the Report dated 11.02.2026 of the Sub-Inspector of Police, Asthawan Police Station, Nalanda, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that both the appellants, namely, Baleshwar Saw and Sushila Devi @ Soshila Devi, are dead.

2. In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and
