2 11-05-2026 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Shikarganj P.S. Case No. 112 of 2024 registered for the offence
under Section(s) 341, 323, 302, 304B/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner and
others are accused of killing the deceased.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence.
Petitioner is in custody since 21.02.2026 and has no criminal
antecedent. It is further submitted that the deceased, who was
the daughter-in-law of the petitioner, died at her parental home.



It is also submitted that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and the submissions advanced on behalf of the petitioner, this application for regular bail is allowed.

7. Accordingly, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Shikarganj P.S. Case No. 112 of 2024.

8. It is made clear that any observation made herein is *prima facie* in nature and limited solely for the purpose of adjudication of the present bail application. Such observations shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and shall not influence the trial or any other proceedings in any manner.
