3 24-04-2026 Perused the Letter No. 279 dated 06.02.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Begusarai along with the Report dated 04.02.2026 of the Sub-Inspector of Police-cum-S.H.O, Sahebpur Kamal Police Station, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Kartik Sah, is dead.
