ORAL ORDER

2 06-05-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with Panapur PS. Case No. 64 of 2026 dated 03-03-2026 instituted under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise (Amendment) Act, 2022.

3. The allegation is of recovery of 150 litres of illicit country made liquor from the wheat field of Raj Kumar Singh.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that no incriminating article has been recovered either from the conscious possession of the petitioner or from his house; rather, the illicit liquor has been recovered from the wheat field of Raj Kumar Singh, which does



not belong to the petitioner. The petitioner has been made an accused in this case only on the basis of disclosure made by the local people of the vicinity. Lastly, it is submitted that one criminal case is pending against him.

5. Learned APP has opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and submissions of learned counsel for the parties, in the event of arrest or surrender before the Court below within six weeks from today, the petitioner be released on bail upon furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 2nd Exclusive Special Excise Judge, Saran at Chapra, in Panapur PS. Case No. 64 of 2026, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of the *Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023* and further (i) that the petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the Court and on his absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his bail bond shall be cancelled by the court below, (ii) that one of the bailors will be his own blood relation, preferably father, mother, brother, sister and or his wife, (iii) that the bailor shall also state on affidavit that he will inform the court concerned if the petitioner is made accused



in any other case of similar nature after his release in the present case and thereafter the court below will be at liberty to initiate the proceeding for cancellation of bail on ground of misuse and (iv) that if the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses, in that case, the prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.

7. The application stands allowed.
