petitioners and Mr. Anirban Kundu, learned SC-24.



2. The present petition has been preferred for the following relief(s):

“(i) Respondents concerned be directed to pay appropriate compensation at new rate as provided under the Land Acquisition Act as well as right to fair compensation and transparency in Land Acquisition Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 herein after to be referred as the Act.

(ii) Respondents concerned be directed to provide due provision for rehabilitation and resettlement of the petitioners and cost of entire infrastructure therefore he made.

(iii) Respondents be further directed to provide job/employment to one member of the family of each petitioners, who have lost their house and occupation besides the source of livelihood on account of acquisition of their house.

(iv) Further the Respondents be directed to grant relief prayed for above during the pendency of this writ application as an interim order.

(v) Any other relief or reliefs to which the



petitioners be found entitled to be granted to them.”

3. After some argument, learned counsel for the petitioner submit that they shall be approaching the appropriate authority for grant of compensation at the new rate.

4. Granting said liberty and expecting the authority to look into the matter and do the needful, the writ petition stands disposed of.
