2. The present petition has been preferred for the following relief(s):

“i) For directing the respondent authorities specially the respondent no.2 to 4 to pay the actual amount of the land which was acquired by the respondent authority whereas the petitioner is a landless person and the said acquired land was his valuable land and the same was for the construction of a house so that the
