6 26-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 918 dated 15.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Madhepura along with the Report dated 15.05.2026 of the S.H.O, Kumarkhand Police Station, Madhepura, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Braj Kishore Yadav @ Buchchan Yadav, is dead.
