3 01-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 236 dated 08.02.2026 of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Muzaffarpur along with the Report dated 06.02.2026 of the S.H.O, Paroo Police Station, Muzaffarpur, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Vilas Thakur @ Bilash Thakur, is dead.
