4 08-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 226 dated 13.02.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Purnia along with the Report dated 04.02.2026 of Inspector of Police-cum-S.H.O, Bhawanipur Police Station, Purnia; wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Upendra Singh, is dead.
