2 12-05-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in Sasaram (M) P. S.

Case No. 100 of 2025 registered for the offence punishable
under Section 317(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.

3. As per prosecution case, informant, namely,
Yogendra Kumar Thakur, alleged that his motorcycles was
stolen by co-accused Badal Kumar.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel appearing on
behalf of the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and has
committed no offence. Petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.
Name of petitioner transpired in this case during course of
investigation on the basis of confessional statement of co-
accused Badal Kumar who was apprehended with the stolen
motorcycle. No incriminating article has been recovered from



possession of this petitioner. Except confessional statement, there is no material on record to show the complicity of this petitioner in the alleged occurrence.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State vehemently opposed the bail application and submitted that petitioner has got six criminal antecedents.

6. Considering the nature of accusation and criminal antecedents, prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is refused.
