The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the order dated 04.07.2018 passed by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate II, Rosera, Samastipur in Complaint Case No. 460(C) of 2017 by which cognizance was taken against the petitioners for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 341, 323, 504 of the I.P.C.
