The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the order dated 30.01.2018 passed by the learned Special Judge, Vigilance, North Bihar, Muzaffarpur in Special Case No. 18 of 2013, arising out of Economic Offence P.S.
