4 07-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 628 dated 01.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Buxar along with the Report dated 01.05.2026 of the Sub-Inspector of Police, Nawanagar Police Station, Buxar, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Brij Kumar Roy, is dead.
