2. The present Cr. Misc. Application has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing the order dated 04.12.2015 passed by learned J.M. 1st Class, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Complaint Case No.C-2327 of 2015 (T.R. No.1276 of 2015 by which the learned Trial Court after finding a prima facie case for offence under Section 420 of the I.P.C. has summoned the petitioner for appearance.

3. *Vide* order dated 03.04.2026 a report regarding status of case was called for, which was received *vide* Letter



No.106 dated 24.04.2026. As per the said report submitted by the learned Trial Court, the above noted case has already been disposed of on 17.07.2019.
