2. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the order dated 03.01.2018 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Patna in G.R. No. 7567 of 2016, Tr. No. 5862 of 2017, arising out of Kankerbagh P.S. Case No. 704 of 2016 whereby cognizance was taken against the petitioners for the offences under Sections 498(A)/34 of the I.P.C. and Section ¾ of D.P. Act.
