2. The present petition has been filed under Section



482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the order dated 20.12.2017 passed by the learned Sub-divisional Judicial Magistrate, Jehanabad in Tehta (Makhdumpur) P.S. Case No. 96 of 2017, Tr. No. 1727 of 2018 by which cognizance was taken against the petitioners under Sections 147, 149, 341, 323, 504 of the I.P.C.
