2. The present Cr. Misc. Application has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing the order dated 07.08.2018 passed by learned S.D.J.M., Nalanda at Bihar Sharif in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No.136 of 2016 by which cognizance under Sections 498(A), 323, 504/34 of the I.P.C. and Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act has been taken against the petitioners.

3. *Vide* order dated 06.04.2026 a report regarding



status of case was called for, which was received *vide* Letter No.25 dated 10.04.2026. As per the said report submitted by the learned Trial Court, the case is pending at the stage of argument.

3. After some argument, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that this case may be disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to take all the points as raised in the petition, before the learned Trial Court at appropriate stage in accordance with law.

4. Learned APP for the State has no objection to this prayer of the petitioners.

5. In view of the above, the present Cr. Misc. Application is disposed of with the liberty to the petitioners, as prayed for.
