3 13-05-2026 Perused the Report No. 281 dated 05.02.2026 of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gaya Ji along with the Report dated 26.01.2026 of the S.H.O., Civil Lines Police Station, Gaya Ji as well as the Certificate of Death dated 24.01.2026 of the Ward Councilor of Ward No. 23, Gaya Municipal Corporation, Gaya Ji; wherein it is indicated that the sole appellant, namely, Pintu Jha, is dead.

In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.
