4 05-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 832 dated 28.04.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Bhojpur, Arrah along with the report dated 27.04.2026 of the Sub-Inspector, Chandi P.S., wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that both the appellants, namely, Rajnath Yadav and Jamuna Yadav, is dead and the death certificate of the appellant is annexed with the said report.
