3 13-03-2026 Perused the Letter No. 210 dated 09.02.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Madhepura along with the Memo No. 633 of 2026 dated 07.02.2026 of the Police Inspector, Madhepura, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Rajendra Yadav @ Rajendra Pd. Yadav, is dead and the death certificate of the appellant is annexed with the said report.
