APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for bail in connection with Sakri P.S. Case No.43 of 2026 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 8(c) and 21(b) of the NDPS Act and under Sections 25(1-b)a, 26 and 25 of the Arms Act.

3. The case of the prosecution, in short, is that from possession of this petitioner, one live cartridge and mobile was recovered. It is alleged that from co-accused Rahul, 64.91 gm of brown sugar like contraband was recovered.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that no contraband has been recovered from the possession of this petitioner; only a live cartridge and mobile has been recovered as per the case of the prosecution. It



has further been submitted that the witnesses of the seizure list are police personnel and police have not complied Section 105 of the BNSS while making seizure. It has lastly been submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 27.02.2026.

5. The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State. He has submitted that the petitioner is having criminal antecedent of one case.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court of learned Principal Session Judge, Madhubani in connection with Sakri P.S. Case No.43 of 2026.
