This application has been preferred assailing the order dated 06.06.2016 passed in Complaint Case No. 1078 (C) of 2015 whereby the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, West Champaran, Bettiah dismissed the complaint under Section 203 of the Cr.P.C., as well as the order dated 24.08.2016 passed in Criminal Revision No. 161 of 2016 by the learned



Sessions Judge, West Champaran, Bettiah affirming the order of the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Champaran, Bettiah.
