Additional Public Prosecutor for the State through video-
conferencing.

2. This application for anticipatory bail arises out of
Dawath P.S. Case No. 38 of 2026, registered for the offence
punishable under Sections 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise
Act.

3. As per the allegation, altogether, 30 liters of illicit
liquor is said to have been recovered from a '*Khalihan*'. The
petitioner was identified by the local Chaukidar to be the person
who fled away from the place of seizure.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. It has
further been submitted that petitioner is not the owner of the



place from where the alleged recovery has been made and it is an open space which is accessible to all. It has further been submitted that the petitioner has enmity with the local Chaukidar and his name has falsely been implicated in this case. It has further been submitted that the procedure of search and seizure as prescribed under Section 103 of the B.N.S.S. has not been followed. It has lastly been submitted that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned counsel for the State opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

6. Heard the parties and perused the record.

7. Considering the facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, in the event of his arrest/surrender within six weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Exclusive Special Judge, Excise Court No.I, Rohtas at Sasaram in connection with Dawath P.S. Case No. 38 of 2026, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita.
