6 08-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 769 dated 02.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Madhepura along with the report dated 01.05.2026 of the Sub-Inspector of Police, Jhandapur P.S., wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Sanjay Kumar Singh @ Sanjay Mehta, is dead.
