4 12-05-2026 Perused the Report No. 465 dated 04.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Siwan, along with the Report dated 01.05.2026 of the S.H.O., Mairwa Police Station, Siwan, as well as the Certificate of Death dated 01.05.2026 of the Ward Member of Ward No.-01 of Gram Panchayat- Raj Akolhi, Block- Jiradai, Siwan; wherein it is indicated that the sole appellant, namely, Paras Lohar, is dead.

In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.



3. Let the trial court record be sent back to the concerned court immediately, if not required in any other cases.
