Learned counsel for the petitioners, learned counsel



for the respondent-University and learned counsel for the respondent-State are present.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the grievance of petitioner nos. 1 and 3 have been redressed. So far as petitioner no. 2 is concerned, he has died during the pendency of the case and no legal heir is coming forward to be substituted. So far as petitioner no. 4 is concerned, he submits that some relief has been extended to him and for remaining dues, the petitioner no. 4 is prepared to file a representation before the Registrar, Lalit Narayan Mithila University, Kameshwar Nagar, Darbhanga.

3. The case against petitioner no. 2 stands abated. Since the grievance of petitioner nos. 1 and 3 has been redressed, therefore, this writ application stands disposed of as having become infructuous.

4. In respect of petitioner no. 4, the petitioner no. 4 is directed to file a representation before the Registrar, Lalit Narayan Mithila University, Kameshwar Nagar, Darbhanga within one month from today. If such a representation is filed within the stipulated time then the Registrar, Lalit Narayan Mithila University, Kameshwar Nagar, Darbhanga is directed to dispose of the same within a further period of four months after



giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. Needless to emphasize that the final order which shall be passed by the Registrar, Lalit Narayan Mithila University, Kameshwar Nagar, Darbhanga should be a reasoned and speaking order. In case, the petitioner no. 4 is found entitled to the relief as he would be claiming through the representation, the same should be extended to the petitioner no. 4 within a further period of three months from the date of passing of the final order.

5. With the aforesaid observation/direction and liberty granted, this writ application is disposed of. All pending interlocutory application(s), if any, shall also be deemed to have been disposed of.
