Senior Superintendent of Police, Bhagalpur along with the
report of Sub Inspector of Police cum S.H.O., Akbarnagar
Police Station dated 11.03.2026, wherein it is indicated that
during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant Hari
Mahaldar has died.

2. In view of the said letters as also section 394 of the
Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to
